About the IICMVA

The **IICMVA** is an all-industry advisory group formed in January 1968 when the *American Association of Motor Vehicle Administrators (AAMVA)* adopted a resolution that an industry committee be formed to work with motor vehicle administrators on matters affecting mutual interests by providing technical expertise and understanding of the subject at hand.

Today the **IICMVA** acts as the official liaison between the insurance industry and Motor Vehicle Departments in the US and Canada and primarily assists with the implementation and maintenance of compulsory insurance and financial responsibility laws. In addition, the **IICMVA** also serves as an advisory group and subject matter expert on other significant motor vehicle administration issues including driver licensing, vehicle titling & branding, vehicle registration, motor vehicle record (MVR) content & availability and the issues surrounding the uninsured motorist.

Membership

Member Companies - Membership is open to insurance companies engaged in the business of insuring motor vehicles and insurance trade organizations, which have motor vehicle insurance companies as their members.

Associate Membership is available to vendors or third party information providers involved in insurance related matters may also apply for non-voting membership.

Dues

Membership dues are paid on a calendar year basis and amounts depend on the type of membership.

- **COMPANY MEMBERSHIP** (Insurance Company and Insurance Trade Organization): \$500
Entitles one representative from each Member Company or trade to attend each of the tri-annual meetings. Additional company representative may attend at an additional cost of \$125 per meeting.
- **ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP** (Vendors & other information providers): \$1000
Entitles two representatives from each associate member to attend each of the tri-annual meetings. Additional representative may attend at an additional cost of \$125 per meeting.
